PROFICIENCY AND CONTENT EXAMS Greek – Hebrew – Old Testament – New Testament

Instead of taking Old and New Testament Survey courses, you may take and pass a Content Exam in each subject. If you pass the exam you may substitute another Old Testament or New Testament course instead of the Survey course. You must take the New Testament and Old Testament exams before you complete your first year of matriculation. If you fail the exam you may *not* try a second time; and you will be required to register for the course within your first year of matriculation.

Proficiency Exams are also offered in Hebrew and Greek languages. These exams consist of grammar and translation questions; and may be taken only once. If you pass you may move directly into your exegesis courses. If you fail the exams, you must take both semesters of the language study.

Exams reservation forms below must be filled out and sent to the Registration Office GCTS – CUME, 90 Warren Street, Roxbury, MA 02119. The Spring date for all four exams is set as Wednesday, January 25, 2012. The day of the exam you may come to CUME offices to **START** the exam from 10:00 AM to 5:00 PM. The exam will take one hour (1 hour) each.
