



A critical aspect of the Pierce Center for Disciple-Building at the Center for Urban Ministerial Education (CUME) is our engagement with the local churches in our communities. Thus, Pierce Fellowship Members are expected to participate in the discipleship ministries of a local church under the supervision of a pastor or other church leader. Pierce Fellowship Members will devote at least 90 minutes per week in church-based discipleship, and will discuss their experiences in regular meetings with each other.

Neither CUME nor the Pierce Center for Disciple-Building will determine what forms of discipleship the Members participate in through a church, but will help each Member to assess what they learn from these experiences. Each participating church will retain full responsibility for the direction and supervision of its own discipleship ministry.
