M.Div. and M.A. students have the opportunity to take the Bible (OT and NT) Competency Exams **only once during new student orientation!** If you do not pass the Bible Competency Exams (OT and NT), or choose not to take the exams **during new student orientation when you begin residential study**, you will be required to take OT 500 (Old Testament Survey) and NT 501 (New Testament Survey) early in your studies in order to complete your program.

Language Proficiency Exams (Hebrew and Greek) are also offered twice a year, typically September and January. However, Language Proficiency Exams may be taken any time during one's program. Please see the current *Student Handbook* for policies and procedures concerning Language Proficiency Exams.
