### IMPORTANT POLICIES REGARDING FULL-SUMMER COURSES

- ◆ All Full-Summer courses - regardless of when they meet - must be registered by the Full-Summer add deadline of May 23, 2012.
- ◆ Students who register for Full-Summer courses are responsible for obtaining a copy of the course syllabus from the professor at the beginning of the term. Generally, students are expected to complete some **REQUIRED PRE-LECTURE WORK** (e.g. reading, papers, exams). The syllabus will clearly note such assignments.
- ◆ If a course requires pre-lecture work and a student does not complete that work to the satisfaction of the professor, he/she will be required to withdraw from the course, receiving a 'W' on his/her transcripts and a partial or no tuition refund. (NOTE: This is an exception to the normal drop/withdrawal policies.)
- ◆ If a course does not require pre-lecture work and that course holds its first class meetings after the last day to drop with a 100% tuition refund, then students who wish to drop such a course and receive a full tuition refund must drop the course by midnight on the first day of class. Students who withdraw from such a course after the above deadline will receive no refund and a 'W' (withdrawn) on their transcripts.
- ◆ Exegesis courses will have a required language competency examination at the start of the term. Any student who does not pass this exam will be immediately dropped from the course with a full tuition refund.
- ◆ All work for Full-Summer courses must be completed and submitted no later than August 17, 2012.

- ◆ Students submitting pass/fail petitions for late-starting courses must do so by the ninth hour of lecture.
