DEFINITIONS FOR CLASSIFICATION PURPOSES:

(Check the correct classification of the incident you are reporting in the box in the left margin)

Sex Offenses - Forcible

Any sexual act directed against another person, forcibly and / or against that person's will; or not forcibly or against the person's will where the victim is incapable of giving consent.

[] A. Forcible Rape

The carnal knowledge of a person, forcibly and / or against that person's will; or not forcibly or against the person's will where the victim is incapable of giving consent because of his/her temporary or permanent mental of physical incapacity (or because of his/her youth).

[] B. Forcible Sodomy

Oral or anal sexual intercourse with another person, forcibly and / or against that person's will; or not forcibly or against the person's will where the victim is incapable of giving consent because of his/her youth or because of his/her temporary or permanent mental of physical incapacity.

[] C. Sexual Assault With An Object

The use of an object or instrument to unlawfully penetrate, however slightly, the genital or anal opening of the body of another person, forcibly and / or against that person's will; or not forcibly or against the person's will where the victim is incapable of giving consent because of his/her youth or because of his/her temporary or permanent mental or physical incapacity.

[] D. Forcible Fondling

The touching of the private body parts of another person for the purpose of sexual gratification, forcibly and / or against the person's will; or, not forcibly or against that person's will where the victim is incapable of giving consent because of his/her youth or because of his/her temporary or permanent mental or physical incapacity.

Sex Offenses - Nonforcible

Unlawful, nonforcible sexual intercourse.

[] A. Incest

Nonforcible sexual intercourse between persons who are related to each other within the degrees wherein marriage is prohibited by law.

[] B. Statutory Rape

Nonforcible sexual intercourse with a person who is under the statutory age of consent.

Sexual Offenses Definitions are from the National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS) Edition of the Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) Program.
