IMPORTANT POLICIES REGARDING LATE-STARTING COURSES

Some courses (i.e. weekend courses) hold their first class meetings *after* the last day for a 100% tuition refund. Please take note of the following policies regarding these late-starting courses:

- " Students who register for a late-starting course are expected to obtain a copy of the course syllabus from the professor at the beginning of the semester.

 Generally, students are expected to complete some reading and other assignments before the first class meeting. The syllabus will clearly note such assignments.
- " Students who wish to drop a late-starting course and receive a 100% tuition refund must do so by the Add/Drop deadline, or by 10:00am the next business day. All classes (late starting included), start with the Formation Session at OCF--for life application and course integration and assimilation. Add/Drop forms may be faxed to 617-541-3432, or emailed to cumereg@gcts.edu.
- " Students who withdraw from a late-starting course after the above deadline may receive a partial refund. These courses will remain on a student's transcript with a 'W' to indicate that the student has withdrawn from the course.
- " Students submitting pass/fail petitions for late-starting courses must do so by the standard deadline as listed in the catalog.

INFORMATION REGARDING SEATING TIME AND TEXTBOOKS

- -- GCTS Boston classes are scheduled for 28-30 hours of classroom seating time, and 15-40 hours of rigorous curricular engagement throughout the semester:
