This opportunity to teach, and to learn from, indigenous student-pastors, evangelists and future church leaders has been hugely valuable in terms of our own spiritual and theological formation -- and has opened hearts to God's mission in East Africa.

- Three-month overseas mission opportunities at Nassa Theological College (Bulima, Tanzania)
- Affiliated with Africa International University (Kenya) and African Inland Church (Tanzania)
- Mentored Ministry Credit available; on-site supervision by ordained pastor/PhD Mission Studies
- Semesters Start in January, May and September. Married students and families are welcome.
- Cost (including travel and on-campus housing) starting at \$3000.

I believe this is a unique opportunity for GCTS students to gain experience and vision for theological education as mission in the global South -- and NTC certainly needs qualified missionary-teachers for their growing certificate- and diploma- programs in theology and missions.
