IMPORTANT POLICIES REGARDING LATE-STARTING COURSES

Some courses (i.e. weekend courses) hold their first class meetings *after* the last day for a 100% tuition refund. Please take note of the following policies regarding these late-starting courses:

- Students who register for a late-starting course are expected to obtain a copy of the course syllabus from the professor at the beginning of the semester. Generally, students are expected to complete some reading and other assignments before the first class meeting. The syllabus will clearly note such assignments.
- Students who wish to drop a late-starting course and receive a 100% tuition refund must notify the Registration Office in writing by 5:00pm on the business day following the first class meeting. If after hours, students may turn in completed drop requests by placing them in the Registration Office's IN box or by faxing them to (617) 541-3432.

^{**} Students who withdraw from a late-starting course after the above deadline will not receive a full refund. These courses will remain on a student's transcript. with a 'W' to indicate that the student has withdrawn from the course. A Saturday/weekend course must be dropped by 1:00 p.m. on the same day in order to receive a full refund.

Students submitting pass/fail petitions for late-starting courses must do so by the standard deadline as listed in the catalog, and/or academic calendar.

INFORMATION REGARDING SEATING TIME AND TEXTBOOKS

- -- GCTS Boston classes are scheduled for 28-30 hours of classroom seating time, and 15-40 hours of rigorous curricular engagement throughout the semester:
