As you may know, Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary plans to leverage part or all of its 102acre property to further its mission in the institution's next chapter. In partnership with the Town of Hamilton, a consultant team was hired to study reuse alternatives for the property, and many of you attended our first community workshop on November 14, 2022.

Since then, the consultant team reviewed what they heard, assessed the site and buildings, and conducted additional market research. We now invite you to join us for a **second community workshop on Thursday, January 26 at 7:00 p.m. at The Community House, 284 Bay Road.** The focus of this conversation is to explore how to integrate the future of the property into Hamilton's broader planning and economic objectives.
