ALL NATIONS

International Executive Leader North America Executive Director

I lead All Nations, an international Christian mission organization founded in 1993 by Floyd and Sally McClung that makes disciples and ignite church movements in 45 countries, predominantly in frontier places and among peoples with no Christians and churches. I succeeded McClung as the International Executive Leader in 2016. All Nations has five regional hubs—Kansas City, U.S.; Cape Town, South Africa; Hamburg, Germany; Kampala, Uganda; and Tainan, Taiwan—that have equipped about 400 cross-cultural workers who have planted thousands of reproducible churches led by thousands of All Nations local church planters. I set the organizational strategic direction and lead the multicultural All Nations International Leadership Team from five continents to guide, guard, and govern the organization.

International Missions & Organizational Expansion

I have proactively expanded All Nations' global footprint from 20 to 45 countries. Firstly, as the former North America Executive Director, I built the hub in Kansas City from a barebones operation into a widely recognized mission organization in the U.S. Secondly, in the past six years as the International Executive Leader, I drove the vision to multiply from two existing regional hubs to five by launching the European hub in Hamburg in 2018, the East African hub in Kampala in 2018, and the Chinese-speaking hub in Taiwan in 2021. My strategic plan is to multiply to ten regional hubs in gateway cities by 2030, so that All Nations can mobilize both cross-cultural and near-cultural workers to the remaining untouched gospel frontiers.

Leadership and Missions: Speaking, Teaching, and Writing

My Doctor of Strategic Leadership degree has provided a critical framework for my 37 years of professional leadership experience. The leadership topics that I speak and write on include: global leadership, transformational leadership, servant leadership, biblical leadership, leadership development, leading through crisis, and women in leadership. I have also been speaking widely on missions at key mission conferences and in churches throughout the U.S. and overseas. I was the plenary speaker at the 2023 Mission ConneXion NW, the 2022 Missio Nexus Leaders Conference, the 2021 GACX Global Alliance for Church Multiplication Forum, and the 2019 Global Mobilization Consultation (GMC) in Brazil. I am a popular instructor for the Perspectives on the World Christian Movement. (Please see attached "Public Speaking and Authorship.")

Starting in January 2023, I am co-leading, mentoring, and teaching a three-year Doctor of Ministry track on "Mission, Development, and Leadership in the Global Christian Context," consisting of global leaders who have served in more than ten countries.

Crisis Management and Leadership

I have led All Nations through several major external and internal crises and empowered All Nations to emerge as a healthier organization with a stronger presence in more countries. My crisis leadership expertise includes, managing crisis teams, conducting international media interviews, communicating with key mission and church leaders, casting vision to mobilize internal stakeholders, and using crisis to create learning communities and shape a resilient cohesive organizational culture. Global Organizational Design and Structure

For my doctoral thesis, I designed a scalable reproducible structure for a global organization that catalyzes church movements among the frontier peoples around the world. This kind of malleable multi-national scaffolding enables All Nations to be nimble and adaptable, even in times such as the COVID-19 pandemic.

Advancing Global Partnerships and Organizing Mission Conferences

In partnership with key missional networks, I have spoken on collaboration and organized several conferences, including Disciple Kansas City in 2017, the International Leadership Institute (ILI) conference in 2016, the Vision 5:9 North American Roundtable in 2015 focused on reaching Muslim unreached peoples, and the Omega Challenge conference in 2016 focused on reaching the Muslim diaspora. I was part of the steering committee that planned the 2015 Chinese Mission Convention (CMC) in Houston. I also coordinated the Unreached People Groups Track for CMC in 2015, 2017, and 2019. I lead the Strategic Leadership Affinity Track at the Global Mobilization Consultation (GMN) in 2017 in Dubai.

Missions Mobilization

I am passionate about people finding their unique role and place in global missions. Through the many speaking opportunity, I have become a significant mobilizer and participate actively in several global mobilization initiatives and projects, including being the keynote speaker at) the 2019 Global Mobilization Consultation (GMC) in Brazil attended by mobilizers from 50+ countries. I am a highly sought-after instructor at the Perspectives for World Christian Movement, of which 20% serve in longterm mission and 21% become mission mobilizers. Subsequently, I assumed similar responsibilities in World Vision Hong Kong on a part-time basis to give time for a young family.
