DEFINITIONS:

Polity: <u>Congregational</u> = major decisions effecting the local church (including ordination) are made by the congregation.

<u>Episcopal</u> = major decisions affecting the local church made by the denominational leadership; ordination approved by bishops.

<u>Presbyterian</u> = major decisions effecting the local church are made by the ruling elder; ordination approved by presbytery.

Theology: Categorizations of these distinctives are taken from a centrist Evangelical perspective. (See further definitions at end of chart.)

Gender: <u>Complementarian</u>* = the view that women may <u>not</u> be ordained nor have leadership positions over men.

<u>Egalitarian</u>* = the view that women \underline{may} be ordained and/or have leadership positions over men.

(*There are modifications and variations on each of these positions.)

Baptism: Pedo/Covenant = infant baptism practiced along with adult convert baptism.

<u>Credo/Believers</u> = believer baptism only.
