

Report on Campus Climate Survey

The Gordon Conwell 2024-2025 campus climate survey was administered to a sample representative group of students during the Spring semester. An email was sent explaining the purpose of the survey and emphasizing the anonymous nature of it. Contact info for supporting help was included—an FAQ document was included in the email. A follow-up reminder email was sent after the initial invitation. The survey questions consisted of the MA DHE model questions in their entirety using Microsoft forms as the instrument. The response rate was approximately 65%.

A meeting was held on June 10, 2025, to review the results with relevant stakeholders present. The results demonstrated that Gordon-Conwell is an exceptionally-safe campus (no incidents, one-two potential stalking situations) and that students know where to go for help and support should they need it (89%). Only 11% thought that they were not confident Gordon-Conwell would respond to an issue of sexual misconduct with appropriate accommodations. There is no prevalence of sexual misconduct on campus, and they are aware of specific services available to victims of sexual misconduct.

Results will be shared with the President's cabinet when the group resumes their regular meetings in the fall, and the cabinet will disseminate information as needed to relevant departments and directors.
