CONTINUATION FEES

As a reminder, continuation fees are applied **twice a year** during the **Spring and Fall Semesters** (subject to change every July). The grace period for completion of the thesis-project following residency is as follows: Candidates in the Doctor of Ministry program will have two (2) years following their final residency to complete the degree without incurring any additional fees. Continuation fees will begin to accrue two (2) years following your last residency. For example, if your third/final residency ends on June 16, 2023, your grace period will end on June 16, 2025, and your first continuation fee will be charged in Fall 2025 (September 2025). Continuation fees are subject to change every academic year.

The most recent continuation fee may be reversed upon the discretion of the Student Accounts office once you have **completed** the post-defense format review process of your thesis-project and have been cleared for graduation by the DMin office. Graduation fees will apply for all students upon completion of the degree requirements and are also subject to change from year to year.

A student does not need to complete degree requirements within a graduation schedule. For example, a student could defend a thesis-project in June and complete all degree requirements, including those pertaining to the thesis-project by August and continuation fees would stop being incurred between August and graduation.
